Standard operating hours

According to statutory guidance, policy statements should provide information on a licensing board's policy on licensing hours. Only off-sales hours are specified in law, with the permitted hours being between 10am to 10pm every day – although licensing boards can decide to limit off-sales hours if they consider it appropriate. It is left to each licensing board to determine the licensed hours for on-licensed premises. This resource outlines details of what boards indicate they regard as being standard operating hours for on-licensed premises in the most recent licensing policies.
