There are 627 places to buy alcohol in Aberdeen:

432 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





195 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Aberdeen, 25% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 19% of women and 31% of men.

This compares to 23% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for 15% of children on the child protection register in Aberdeen.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2021-22.

There were 1,299 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Aberdeen in 2021-22.

Alcohol related hospital statistics 2021-22.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

In Aberdeen, 49 people died because of alcohol in 2022, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was similar to Scotland as a whole.



Alcohol-specific deaths 2022.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over 3 times as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

NHS Health Scotland.

33% of 13-year-olds and 67% of 15-year-olds in Aberdeen have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, 50% of 13-year-olds and 71% of 15-year-olds have been drunk.

Every year, alcohol costs Aberdeen £120.92m or £577 per person.
