246 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





88 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Angus, 24% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 21% of women and 27% of men.

This compares to 23% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.





Parental drinking was a concern identified for 19% of children on the child protection register in Angus.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2021-22.

52% of S2 and S4 students in Angus drink alcohol.

22% of S2 and S4 students in Angus drink alcohol at least once a month.

There were 642 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Angus in 2021-22.

Alcohol related hospital statistics 2021-22.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.





In Angus, 27 people died because of alcohol in 2022, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was similar to Scotland as a whole.



Alcohol-specific deaths 2022.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over 3 times as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Every year, alcohol costs Angus £33.46m or £302 per person.
