In Moray, 21% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 15% of women and 30% of men.

This compares to 23% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for 26% of children on the child protection register in Moray.

57% of S2 and S4 students in Moray drink alcohol.

27% of S2 and S4 students in Moray drink alcohol at least once a month.

There were 477 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Moray in 2021-22.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

In Moray, 13 people died because of alcohol in 2022, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over 3 times as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Every year, alcohol costs Moray £33.31m or £380 per person.
