There are 105 places to buy alcohol in Na h-Eileanan Siar:

67 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





38 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Na h-Eileanan Siar, 16% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 11% of women and 20% of men.

This compares to 23% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.



Parental drinking was a concern identified for 55% of children on the child protection register in Na h-Eileanan Siar.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2021-22.

34% of 13-year-olds and 63% of 15-year-olds in Na h-Eileanan Siar have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, 60% of 15-year-olds have been drunk.*

There were 288 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Na h-Eileanan Siar in 2021-22.

Alcohol related hospital statistics 2021-22.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.





In Na h-Eileanan Siar, 16 people died because of alcohol in 2022, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was higher than Scotland as a whole.



Alcohol-specific deaths 2022.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over 3 times as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Every year, alcohol costs Na h-Eileanan Siar £9.94m or £379 per person.
