In Perth & Kinross, 22% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk auidelines.

This includes 15% of women and 30% of men.

This compares to 23% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

45% of S2 and S4 students in Perth & Kinross drink alcohol.

There were 741 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Perth & Kinross in 2021-22.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

In Perth & Kinross, 32 people died because of alcohol in 2022, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was lower then Scotland as a whole.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over 3 times as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.
