In Angus, 20% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 17% of women and 25% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for 24% of children on the child protection register in Angus.

There were 684 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Angus in 2022-23.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

In Angus, 29 people died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was lower than Scotland as a whole.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over twice as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.
