Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Argyll & Bute, 23% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 15% of women and 32% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for 7% of children on the child protection register in Argyll & Bute.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

44% of 13-year-olds and 78% of 15-year-olds in Argyll & Bute have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, 56% of 13-year-olds and 74% of 15-year-olds have been drunk.

There were 627 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Argyll & Bute in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.






In Argyll & Bute, 22 people died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.
