(pubs and restaurants)



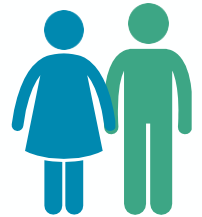
67 off-sales premises

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In East Dunbartonshire, **24% of people** drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes **17% of women** and **32% of men**.

This compares to **20% of people** in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for **29% of children** on the child protection register in East Dunbartonshire.

There were **435 alcohol-related hospital admissions** in East Dunbartonshire in 2022-23.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

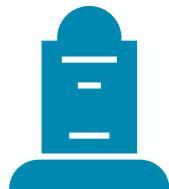


In East Dunbartonshire, **11 people** died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The **true number** of alcohol deaths is **over twice as high** when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Public Health Scotland.

25% of 13-year-olds and **70% of 15-year-olds** in East Dunbartonshire have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, **44% of 13-year-olds** and **75% of 15-year-olds** have been drunk.

Every year, alcohol costs East Dunbartonshire **£25.50m** or **£244 per person**.

This includes:
