(pubs and restaurants)

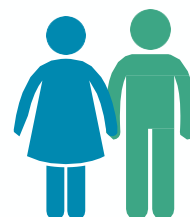


140 off-sales premises

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Falkirk, **22% of people** drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes **18% of women** and **28% of men**.



This compares to **20% of people** in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for **35% of children** on the child protection register in Falkirk.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

There were **975 alcohol-related hospital admissions** in Falkirk in 2022-23.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

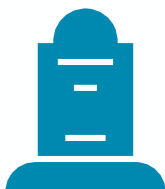


In Falkirk, **36 people** died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was lower than Scotland as a whole.

The **true number** of alcohol deaths is **over twice as high** when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Public Health Scotland.

45% of S2 and S4 students in Falkirk drink alcohol.

20% of S2 and S4 students in Falkirk drink alcohol at least once a month.

Every year, alcohol costs Falkirk **£55.80m or £364 per person**.

This includes:

Health Service	£6.40m
Social Care	£7.34m
Crime	£22.55m
Productive Capacity	£19.51m
