

## Na h-Eileanan Siar Alcohol Profile

September 2025

There are 105 places to buy alcohol in Na h-Eileanan Siar:

67 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





38 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Na h-Eileanan Siar, 16% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 12% of women and 22% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

There were 342 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Na h-Eileanan Siar in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

Every year, alcohol costs Na h-Eileanan Siar £9.94m or £379 per person.

34% of 13-year-olds and 63% of 15-year-olds in Na h-Eileanan Siar have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, 60% of 15-year-olds have been drunk.\*

In Na h-Eileanan Siar, 6 people died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over twice as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.
