(pubs and restaurants)

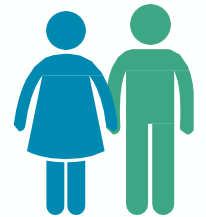


321 off-sales premises

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In North Lanarkshire, **20% of people** drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes **12% of women** and **30% of men**.



This compares to **20% of people** in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for **24% of children** on the child protection register in North Lanarkshire.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

32% of 13-year-olds and **70% of 15-year-olds** in North Lanarkshire have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, **59% of 13-year-olds** and **75% of 15-year-olds** have been drunk.

There were **2,391 alcohol-related hospital admissions** in North Lanarkshire in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

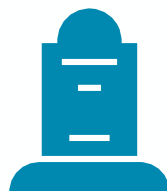


In North Lanarkshire, **115 people** died because of alcohol in 2023, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

The **true number** of alcohol deaths is **over twice as high** when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Public Health Scotland.

Every year, alcohol costs North Lanarkshire **£116.75m** or **£358 per person**.

This includes:

Health Service	£14.59m
Social Care	£9.26m
Crime	£48.83m
Productive Capacity	£44.08m
