There are 589 places to buy alcohol in Perth & Kinross:

436 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





153 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

In Perth & Kinross, 27% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 16% of women and 37% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.





Parental drinking was a concern identified for 22% of children on the child protection register in Perth & Kinross.

45% of S2 and S4 students in Perth & Kinross drink alcohol.

22% of S2 and S4 students in Perth & Kinross drink alcohol at least once a month.

There were 807 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Perth & Kinross in 2022-23.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.





In Perth & Kinross, 24 people died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was lower than Scotland as a whole.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over twice as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.
