271 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





117 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In South Ayrshire, 27% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 19% of women and 35% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the quidelines.





Parental drinking was a concern identified for 21% of children on the child protection register in South Ayrshire.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

50% of S2 and S4 students in South Ayrshire drink alcohol.

25% of S2 and S4 students in South Ayrshire drink alcohol at least once a month.

There were 615 alcohol-related hospital admissions in South Ayrshire in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.



In South Ayrshire, 18 people died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was lower than Scotland as a whole.





The true number of alcohol deaths is over twice as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.
