(pubs and restaurants)



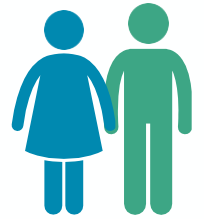
253 off-sales premises

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In South Lanarkshire, **22% of people** drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes **14% of women** and **30% of men**.

This compares to **20% of people** in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for **19% of children** on the child protection register in South Lanarkshire.

35% of 13-year-olds and **74% of 15-year-olds** in South Lanarkshire have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, **55% of 13-year-olds** and **73% of 15-year-olds** have been drunk.

There were **1,965 alcohol-related hospital admissions** in South Lanarkshire in 2024-25.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

In South Lanarkshire, **75 people** died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was higher than Scotland as a whole.

The **true number** of alcohol deaths is **over twice as high** when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Every year, alcohol costs South Lanarkshire **£93.83m** or **£301 per person**.

This includes:

Social Care	£10.83m
Crime	£36.16m
Productive Capacity	£36.13m
