There are 230 places to buy alcohol in West Dunbartonshire:

140 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





90 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In West Dunbartonshire, 20% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk auidelines.

This includes 16% of women and 25% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.





Parental drinking was a concern identified for 14% of children on the child protection register in West Dunbartonshire.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

32% of 13-year-olds and 69% of 15-year-olds in West Dunbartonshire have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol. 72% of 13-year-olds and 71% of 15-year-olds

have been drunk.

There were 744 alcohol-related hospital admissions in West Dunbartonshire in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.





In West Dunbartonshire, 28 people died because of alcohol in 2024, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.
